CART RIDING

An update to our golf cart riding policies. Due to availability, we cannot guarantee individual golf carts. Foursomes will be provided with two golf carts. Threesomes will be provided with two golf carts and paired up with another single sharing the cart. Single players should be prepared to share a cart. If you would like to take your own single rider golf cart during the round, there will be an additional fee charged. Masks are recommended when riding in a golf cart when physical distancing cannot be maintained.

Men who are 55 years of age or older can sign up to play in a Senior Flight. The entry fee is \$129 which includes greens fee, cart, range balls, awards, box lunch, tee gift, and prize fund. The fee includes a 1 hour full bag fitting, a dozen Callaway golf balls, and a premium Callaway glove. The fitting fee will be applied

The new Titleist TSi drivers feature an innovative new clubface which uses unique high strength titanium. The titanium is used in military armor applications, commercial jet engines, and NASA's Phoenix Mars Lander. This unique material is the key to creating a face that delivers increased ball speed at every point of contact. The TSi2 Driver is a larger head aimed at producing higher launch and lower spin. The TSi3 Driver is the more traditional pear-

Marisa Baena was a first team All-American for the University of Arizona Women's Team from 1996-1998. Baena won ten tournaments while at the U of A including the Pac-10 Championship. Marisa claimed the individual NCAA title in 1996. Marisa Baena won the 1996 Honda Sports Award for the being the best collegiate female golfer in the nation. In 2005, Marisa won the HSBC Women's World Match Play Championship on the LPGA She and her sister Tour. represented Christina their home country of Colombia in the 2006 Women's World Cup of Golf.

GOLF TIP: FAIRWAY WOODS

With a fairway wood, you want the club to sweep the turf as it approaches the ball. Address the ball with light grip pressure, and relax your forearms and shoulders. Position the ball forward in the stance one to two inches inside the left heel. A wide stance will allow a full turn of the upper body. Swing the club away low and slow on the backswing and also keep the club head low through impact. You will not need to help the ball into the air. Let the loft of the club do the work for you. A lofted fairway wood may be a great replacement for one of your long irons!
