### **U.S. OPEN LOCAL QUALIFIER RECAP**

Sewailo Golf Club hosted a U.S. Open Local Qualifier on May 6th. The local qualifiers included University of Arizona Men's Golf Assistant Coach Chris Nallen with the low round of 63. Other local qualifiers included Chris Korte finishing with a 65 and Andre Metzger with a 66. University of Arizona Men's Golf had two local qualifiers with Sam Sommerhouser who fired a 66 and David Laskin with a 67. Spots in the U.S. Open field will be filled by golfers who play their way into the championship via local and sectional qualifying. The players who advance through local qualifying will play in a 36-hole sectional qualifier

### **DRIVE, CHIP, & PUTT LOCAL QUALIFIER**

The Drive, Chip, and Putt Local Qualifier was held on May 16th. Competitors

included 115 junior boys and girls ages 7 to 15. The juniors compete in separate divisions in four age categories. Participants compete in all three skill competitions (Drive, Chip, and Putt) and hit three shots per skill for a total of nine shots. Points are accumulated per shot at each skill. 24 juniors advanced to sub-regional qualifying at TPC Summerlin at Las Vegas. The juniors are one step closer to the finals to be held at Augusta National the Sunday before the Masters Tournament

## GOLF TIP OF THE MONTH – PLAYING #4

The tee shot at Sewailo's 4th hole is a fun challenge that demands accuracy. This hole is a dogleg left with a stream running up the left side. Select the best line off the tee and the correct

club that will land in the fairway. Your drive needs to fit in between the left and right fairway bunker. The safe play off the tee is to drive more to the right side and land short of the right fairway bunker. There is more risk involved the farther left you play your drive. The farther left you

go, you bring in a couple of fairway bunkers and the stream into play. Once you have successfully executed the tee shot, you will be set up to score well on this hole. Be sure to select enough club to clear the lake in front of the green.
