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## DID YOU KNOW? - NOTAH BEGAY III

Notah Begay is the course designer of Sewailo along with Ty Butler. Begay's NB3 Consulting company has also built other courses including Sequoyah National and Firekeeper Golf Course. Notah Begay III was a teammate of Tiger Woods at Stanford, winning the NCAA

Division 1 Men's Championship there in 1994. A four-time PGA Tour winner, Notah shot 59 during the Nike Tour's Dominion Open in 1998. Notah Begay represented the United States in the 2000 President's Cup, where he paired with Tiger Woods to compile a 3-2 record and helped the US Team to victory. Begay works for the Golf Channel and NBC as an on-course reporter and analyst. Notah

Begay established the non-profit NB3 Foundation. The Foundation improves the lives of Native American children by supporting culturally centered programs and providing direct opportunities for Native youth to live healthy lives.

## GOLF TIP: PLAYING HOLE #18

Sewailo's 18th hole is a challenging tee shot. This shot demands accuracy to avoid the fairway bunkers to the left and the lake all the way up the right side. You have multiple club options for the tee shot. Favor the left side of the fairway with your tee shot. Be careful not to drive the ball too far up the

right side, as the fairway slopes toward the lake that runs all the way up to the green. Visualize your line of play from behind the ball. Once you have successfully executed the tee shot, you will be in good position for the second shot. Select the correct club that lands safely onto the green and avoids the green side bunkers. Do not take too much club as any shots flying long will be wet in the lake behind the green.
