GOLF TIP: Knockdown in the Wind

When playing in the wind, you want the ball to stay low and out of the air by hitting a knockdown shot. Position the ball back in your stance, just to the right of center. Widen your stance to have the correct balance and flex your knees. Weight should be favoring your left side. Take more club and swing easy to reduce backspin. You can make a three-quarter length or a full length backswing. Keep your hands low when you swing through the ball and maintain your balance. Finish low in the follow through to keep the ball low. The knockdown is a safe way to play under pressure when you need extra control on your iron shots.
