GOLF TIP: FAIRWAY BUNKER SHOT

You can hit a successful fairway bunker shot with a few tips. If there is a severe front lip, get the ball back in play by taking a lofted club and hitting the ball

safely back to the fairway. If the lie is better and lip is not in your way, you can take less loft and go for the green. Take a light stance in the sand and do not dig in too much. Spread your feet slightly wider to keep the lower body quiet. Play the ball back in your stance one to two inches to assure that the club hits the

ball before the sand. You want to make ball first contact and hit a little bit of sand out in front of the ball. The ideal swing picks the ball out cleanly. Move your body weight through the shot toward your target. Do not try to overpower the shot and swing with good tempo.
