




















GENERAL HOUSE RULES

- 1. No one under the age of 21 is permitted in the bingo hall.
- 2. It is the player's responsibility to call bingo loud enough for the caller to stop the game prior to the letter of the next ball being called. Attendants are allowed to assist the caller to stop the game when possible.
- As a service to our guests, bingo attendants may tend to a player's cards for a period of no longer than 1 game. In the event an attendant claims bingo in the guest's absence a separate attendant must verify the winning card.
- 4. Once the caller starts to call the letter of the next number, no previous bingos will be honored and the game will continue.
- A bingo is only considered valid on the last number called; the ball on the monitor is not valid until called.
- Electronic devices, Flash boards, and TV monitors are for the guest's convenience only and any malfunctions voids pays and plays.
- 7. Once the caller has officially closed the game no more bingos will be honored.
- 8. A dauber must be used to mark paper bingo cards.
- There are no cash refunds; in the event of a session cancellation, guest's admission receipt is redeemable within two (2) week.
- No splitting or sharing of packs is permitted.
- In the event there are multiple winners in a game, the published payout will be divided accordingly amongst the winners.
- 12. All paper must be purchased from the cashiers and used the day of purchase. No paper may be used or reused once the game has been officially closed.

- 13. Taxable Jackpots, Sunburst, Fireball, and MPBingo require a signed or player's card coded admission receipt to be valid. If a player is unable to sign, then someone must sign on behalf of the guest.
- 14. Winnings of \$1,200 or more are subject to IRS and Title 31 regulations. Guests must provide two (2) forms of legal identification when claiming a payout; Non-U.S. Citizens are also subject to U.S. Tax Regulations.
- 15. Management reserves the right to refuse service to any person; to change modify or cancel any promotions, rules and/or games at any time with prior notification to the Tribal Gaming Office.
- 16. In the event a dispute is not covered by these rules, management will make all final decisions.
- 17. Please place cell phones or other devices in silent mode.
- 18. Guests may have conversations at a respectable volume level. Concerns should be brought to the attention of management to decide acceptable levels. Guests should not confront others.
- 19. Cigar and pipe smoking are not permitted in the bingo hall.
- 20. There is no reserving or saving of seats for other players. Reservations for Fix Base units may be made with management prior to session sales.
- 21. Casino Del Sol is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.
- 22. Must be bought into the early bird and late bird sessions in order to play the jackpot specials.
