EPSON TOUR TOURNAMENT RECAP

Madison Young is the 2024 Casino Del Sol Classic Champion! Young held the lead going into the final round after tying her career best score of

7-under 65. Young shot three outstanding rounds of 69-65-71 to finish at 11-under par. In the final round, the 27-year old played holes 5 through 8 in 6-under par. Young's front nine included a run with birdie-eagle-birdie-eagle to open up a 5 shot lead heading into the back nine. Madison held on to



win by one shot over a group of six other players. This was Young's first victory on the Epson Tour. Also, the win jumped Young into the top 5 in the Race for the LPGA card.

U.S. OPEN LOCAL QUALIFIER RECAP

Sewailo Golf Club hosted a U.S. Open Local Qualifier on May 6th. The local qualifiers included University of Arizona Men's Golf Alumni Trevor Werbylo with the low round of 66. Other local qualifiers included Jonathan Walters and Grant Hirschman both firing a 67. The other local qualifier was Patrick Flavin finishing with a 68. Spots in the U.S. Open field will be filled by golfers who play their way into the championship via local and sectional qualifying. The players who advance through local qualifying will play in a 36-hole sectional qualifier.

DRIVE, CHIP, AND PUTT

The Drive, Chip, and Putt Local Qualifier was held on May 19th. Competitors included 112 junior boys and girls ages 7 to 15. The juniors compete in separate divisions in four age categories. Participants compete in all three skill competitions (Drive, Chip, and

Putt) and hit three shots per skill for a total of nine shots. Points are accumulated per shot at each skill. 24 juniors advanced to sub-regional qualifying at Omni Tucson National. The juniors are one step closer to the finals to be held at Augusta National the Sunday before the Masters Tournament.

SNAKES

Be aware of your surroundings everywhere on the golf course. Sewailo has wildlife including rattlesnakes. If you ever encounter a rattlesnake, put a large distance between you and the snake – at least 15 feet. If the snake is coiled with its head raised, this means the snake

is in defense mode and could strike. Get even further away. Be careful when looking for any golf balls hit out in the desert. When it is hot outside, snakes seek shade. Use caution when going for a ball in a shady area.

MERCHANDISE PRODUCT OF THE MONTH - CALLAWAY JAWS RAW WEDGES

Callaway Jaws Raw Wedges have a raw face which promotes maximum spin with the most aggressive grooves in golf. The wedges also have tungsten technology. Tungsten in the wedge gives the club a balanced weight for increased feel, trajectory control, and

forgiveness. Raw wedges reduce the material between the golf ball and grooves to give maximum friction as the golf ball runs up the face. The groove-in-groove technology promotes added spin on both straight-faced and open-faced shots. There are 17 loft and grind combinations available.



GOLF TIP: GREEN READING

Great putters have the ability to read greens well. Many golfers under read the break, leaving the ball below the hole with no chance to go in. Keys to consider include the speed of the green, surrounding terrain

and slopes, and even playing partners' shots. As you approach the green, look at which side of the green is higher. Are you putting uphill or downhill? It is important that a ball arrive at the beginning of a downhill tier with just the right speed. Also, your ball needs to arrive at the

top of an uphill tier with enough speed to get the ball to the hole. If there is a pond or a body of water nearby, the ball will tend to break toward the water. Pick out a target along your line and commit yourself to aim at the target.
