Sewailo is a Loyalty Points Program where you earn one point per dollar for greens fee, merchandise, lesson, food and beverage, and range pass purchases. The Team Sewailo card is \$125 + tax for a single and \$220 + tax for a couple. The loyalty card includes one complimentary round of golf with the purchase. Cardholders will receive a discounted Team Sewailo cardholder rate when reserving tee times along with 10% off regular

SNAKES

Be aware of your surroundings everywhere on the golf course. Sewailo has wildlife including rattlesnakes. If you ever encounter a rattlesnake, put a large distance between you and the snake – at least 15 feet. If the snake is coiled

with its head raised, this means the snake is in defense mode and could strike. So, get even further away. Be careful when looking for any golf balls hit out in the desert. When it is hot outside, snakes seek shade. Use caution when going for a ball in a shady area.

GOLF TIP OF THE MONTH: CHIPPING FROM TIGHT LIES

A good set up will help you with chipping from a tight lie. Grip down on the club for more control and stand closer to the ball. The shaft will be more upright at address, the

heel off the ground, and the toe will be interacting with the turf. Your club shaft at address will be straighter up and down. You will not want excessive forward shaft lean to make the club dig. The club face will be slightly open. Weight will be more on your front foot. Ball position can be slightly back of center for

more roll or in the center of your stance for less roll. Swing your arms and shoulders. There should be minimal wrists involved. Hit down on the ball and do not try to help the ball up. You have club options for this shot. May want to consider less loft including a pitching wedge, 9, 8, or 7 iron.
