Male and female participants with a current ghin handicap are eligible to play. #### **DID YOU KNOW?**

The green on Hole #1 and #8 was designed to be Notah Begay and Ty Butler's ode to links golf and inspired by St. Andrews. This enormous double green is 29,000 square feet! If you overshoot the pin and are long on

your approach, you could potentially have a very long putt back to the pin. The enormous green makes for some fun putts and a lot of pin locations. You want to be below the hole as much as possible on either the first or eighth green so you can have an uphill putt to the hole. If

you hit a solid approach shot, you will have a good chance at making a birdie.



# GOLF TIP: THE FLOP SHOT

The Flop Shot may be a shot you need during your round if you are playing over a bunker or a water hazard. This shot can be played when the ball is in the fairway or light rough where the ball is sitting up. Grab your highest

lofted wedge. Setup with an open clubface and aim your body left. Also, setup with a wide stance with your feet. Your weight can favor the left side with about 60 to 70 percent of your weight on the left side. This will help you hit down on the shot. The ball position will be more forward of center in your stance to have the

maximum loft. Swing the club back slightly to the outside and hinge your wrists quickly. The further you swing back, the longer and higher the shot will go. Accelerate through and turn your body toward the target. Be sure to practice this shot before taking it to the course.
